New Student Orientation FAQs/Spring 2025

Is Orientation required?

Yes. All new students are required to attend Orientation. During orientation, students learn about various campus resources and departments considered essential to their success while attending Mount Marty University. Getting off to a great start at Mount Marty is much easier when students know where to go, how to get there, where to study, and who to ask for help.

Should family members attend orientation?

Family members are welcome. Please let us know how many family members will be attending New Student Orientation with you so we can plan lunch for them on Friday, January 3.

How long will it take?

New Student Orientation is a full day event.

What do I need to bring?

New students should bring one form of ID, their laptop, their class schedule (if they have a copy of it), their car's license plate numbers/letters, and a copy of immunization records (if these were not previously sent.)

What happens at Orientation?

Orientation is designed to provide you with the information you need to be successful during your time at MMU. You will meet a variety of faculty and staff that will guide you through information sessions to assist you with the transition to MMU. You will have the opportunity to meet other new students as well.

Will lunch be provided during Orientation?

Yes, lunch will be provided for all new students and registered family members on Friday, January 3, 2025. For residential students with a meal plan, regular food service and hours begin on Sunday, January 5, 2025 at 5 pm. The Student Engagement Office will provide meals and/or sack lunches to residential students for Friday evening, Saturday morning, Saturday evening, and Sunday morning.
